CALL TO ORDER: A panel of the Board was called to order at 9:10 a.m.

PRELIMINARY MATTERS: Dr. Clements noted that he had done some expert work for Mr. Wimbish approximately 10 years ago. No one raised an objection to Dr. Clements' participation in the hearing.

DISCUSSION: Dr. Dula Razzolini appeared before the Board in person in accordance with the Board's Notice of Formal Hearing dated May 21, 2025. Dr. Dula Razzolini was represented by Carlyle R. Wimbush, Esquire and Kenneth Roeber, Esquire.

The Board received evidence and sworn testimony from witnesses called by the parties and from Dr. Dula Razzolini regarding the allegations in the Notice.

CLOSED SESSION: Upon a motion by Dr. Clements, and duly seconded by Dr. Vaughan, the Committee voted to convene a closed meeting pursuant to §2.2-3711.A(16) of the Code of Virginia, for the purpose of consideration and discussion of medical and mental health records of Dr. Dula Razzolini. Additionally, he moved that Mr. Saunders, Dr. Harp and Ms. Hines attend the closed meeting because their presence in the closed meeting was deemed necessary and would aid the Committee in its discussion.

RECONVENE: Having certified that the matters discussed in the preceding closed session met the requirements of §2.2-3712 of the Code, the Committee re-convened in open session and continued its discussion with Dr. Dula Razzolini regarding the allegations.

CLOSED SESSION: Upon a motion by Dr. Clements, and duly seconded by Ms. Fonseca, the Board voted to convene a closed meeting pursuant to §2.2-3711.A (27) of the Code of Virginia, for the purpose of deliberation to reach a decision in the matter of Dr. Dula Razzolini. Additionally, he moved that Mr. Saunders, Dr. Harp and Ms. Hines attend the closed meeting because their presence in the closed meeting was deemed necessary and would aid the Board in its deliberations.



DECISION: Upon a motion by Mr. Blanton, and duly seconded by Dr. McManus, the Board made certain findings of fact and conclusions of law and voted to reinstate Dr. Dula Razzolini's license on certain terms and conditions and to issue a reprimand.

VOTE: The vote was unanimous.

ADJOURNMENT: The Board adjourned at 3:20 p.m.
