Find out about a project to improve safety on Route 220 in Henry County. The project includes improvements to intersections and ramps from US-58 to the area of Marrowbone Circle. The project also includes improvements to the intersection of US-220 and Route 87.

The Commonwealth Transportation Board (CTB) will host this required public hearing, pursuant to §33.2-202. The purpose of the public hearing is to seek the public's input on the project and its advancement. VDOT representatives will be available to discuss the project and answer questions.
