1. Welcome John V. Mazza, Jr.

2. New Board Member Introductions John V. Mazza, Jr. Chairman

Mr. Mazza introduced the new board members. Derek "Dak" Hardwick will be serving Region 3, and Daniel "Bud" Oakey will be serving Region 5.

## 4. 2014-2015 Airport Capital Program

J. Michael Swain DOAV

Mr. Swain presented a Virginia Resources Authority (VRA) project request from the Charlottesville Albemarle Airport in the amount of \$1,280,000 for the Parking Lot Expansion project. He noted that the staff recommended endorsing the loan application.

Mr. Swain reviewed the funds available for allocation by the board. During the review, he reported that an updated Transportation Trust Fund figure, lower than the previous figure, was received by DOAV after the board package was distributed. The funds available for allocation by the board were revised due to the decrease in the Transportation Trust Fund allotment and administrative increases awarded during July 2014.

Mr. Swain provided the quarterly reports on the effect of the increased AIP match and the reimbursed cost of site plan reviews changed by localities. To date, the increase in the state match has not adversely impacted the ability to fund projects. During the last quarter, DOAV did not reimburse any funds for site plan reviews.

Mr. Swain presented a request for the Culpeper Regional Airport for an 120-day extension to the tentative allocation for the T-hangars and Box Hangar Site Preparation (Construction) project awarded May 22, 2014, in the amount of \$1,725,000. Staff recommended a 90-day extension.

Mr. Swain reviewed the entitlements funds allocations for Fiscal Year 2015. For new attendees, he explained that entitlement funds are distributed to air carrier airport sponsors in three payments per fiscal year. Mr. Swain presented the FY2014 Entitlement Utilization Report for the Newport News/Williamsburg International Airport. Staff had reviewed the report and found all in order; staff recommended approving the report.

Mr. Swain highlighted the allocation spreadsheets for the six funding programs. Mr. Inman complimented staff on resolving issues with old outstanding capital tentative allocations. He asked about the status of the tentative allocation issued for the Farmville Regional Airport in 2008. Mr. Swain and Mr. Denny, with DOAV's Airport Services Division, responded that the project had been pushed back in the federal program. Issues with the appraisals and other supporting documentation needed for acquisition delayed the project. Approvals were provided by FAA in July, and federal and state grants should soon be offered.

Mr. Swain presented the project requests and staff recommendations. He shared that if the board followed staff recommendations, the following state discretionary funds would be available after the meeting:

During the review of project requests for Region 3, Mr. Hardwick asked staff for a summary of the situation that lead to staff's recommendation to not fund the terminal reconstruction project at the Culpeper Regional Airport. Mr. Swain provided a brief summary of the project originally designed for a substantial two-story building on a new site at the airport. The construction of the building and site were separated. The construction of the site was completed, with an \$500,000 investment by the state. Due to the downturn in the economy, the county determined that it could not move forward with the construction of the building as the county had so many other needs. In response to repeated staff inquiries on the status of building a new terminal on the new site, the county has said it still plans to construction the building. The county now wants to upgrade the existing terminal. Staff has reviewed the plan for the upgrade and sees it as a terminal replacement. Staff expressed concern that if the upgrade is completed, the new building on the new site may not get built.

Ms. Tanya Woodward, Culpeper Regional Airport manager, provided information with the board. She assured the board that the county plans to build on the new site, but it cannot afford to put the needed funds into the project at the present time. She said the airport is growing rapidly and is a welcome center for economic development in the county. The current building does not meet county needs. In addition, the county would lose federal funding if the state did not participate in funding the upgrade. Ms. Woodward confirmed that the new terminal would still be a two-story structure. Changes in the design would need to be made to match the building code, which changed since the original design was completed.

Mr. Mazza asked if the state's grant assurances addressed reimbursement if the state participated in the updated and the new terminal was subsequently built. Mr. Swain responded that reimbursement to the state would be required when the use of the existing building changed.

Also during the review of project requests for Region 3, Mr. Hardwick asked when the ongoing environmental assessment at the Stafford Regional Airport was expected to be completed. Mr. Denny responded that the environmental assessment project had just started and was expected to be complete in approximately 12 months.
