Dear Mr. Olson:

Somehow it took from January to December for the board to act on the investigator's findings in the meager way it did. The resulting slap on the wrist given the contractor demonstrates the department's lack of interest and/or inability to protect the public.

The board did not even consider or penalize the contractor's failure to comply with Virginia law regarding identified underground utilities located within two feet of an excavation. Ignoring that clear violation of Virginia law (not some technical regulation) is an outrageous failure by the your staff which exposed the owner to danger from the buried gas transmission main and cost her over \$7,000 in charges by Washington Gas.

Further, imposing a mere \$700 penalty for the contractor's use of an unlicensed person to perform life-safety critical electrical work on the project does not demonstrate any concern for the owner's safety and is an insult to the idea the board sets and enforces important rules applicable to general contractors. Apparently falsifying an electrical permit application to the City of Alexandria and giving false statements regarding subcontractor lien releases are acceptable to your department as these egregious violations were ignored.

In the course of the department's consideration of this complaint, I learned that the investigator assigned to the complaint resigned and her email account was terminated without anyone in your department assigned to follow up on subsequent email correspondence. Apparently this was not an oversight but is departmental policy. Perhaps the five minutes it would take to transfer her emails to another staff member was too much effort. It shows how little importance the department gives to complaints against license holders.

I will advise anyone not to waste their time when asked whether filing a complaint to your department is useful or will result in appropriate punishment of contractor wrongdoing.

Currently the board is again considering the threshold for differentiation between AES and H/H licensing, when it comes to solar PV installations. If a change is made in December, it would be the second revision to what license is required being made by the board in a 1 years timeline. What license should be required for a given work is a weighty matter, and one that should be made after careful consideration. For this reason I think the board should not be making an immediate change to the license requirement. Instead, I believe the board should engage in a more lengthy process of soliciting stakeholder feedback before making a decision. During this time, board staff may need to grant some temporary flexibility to new applicants and existing contractors. Secondly I offer some suggestions on how best to craft the license scope rules:

In my view electrical contractors should be the only contractors allowed to do the electrical portion of solar PV work. However if the board is going to allow other than electrical contractors to do the work, I think the current proposal of a 500 KVA limit could be problematic. If the board is going to allow other licenses to do the work I have three suggestions:

1. The board board should allow electrical contractors to do solar on non-utility owned customer premises, regardless of size of system. If the board is unwilling to allow this I think that we should at least allow electrical contractors to do this work with no more than a documented 10 hour solar training program and a test (meaning if they have electrical experience no need to require a set number of years for solar specific experience).

Reason(s):

- This allowance is consistent with how we have viewed electrical work all along. Differentiation between Utility Contracting and Electrical Contracting often doesn't fall upon type of electrical equipment, system size (KVA), or even voltage. Rather, it is differentiated by whether the system is owned by a customer or a utility. Also, related to this is the differentiation between whether the NEC (what electricians are expected to know) or NESC is applicable to work. This is also based on ownership. Thus, on a customer owned premises, it would seem to fall in line with long-standing practice to consider this as always under the purview of electrical contractors.

Non-electrical contractors would be allowed to do solar under a restricted set of circumstances outlined below:

2. AES contractors' allowed work could be on non-utility customer premises including on buildings and field mounted installations. The allowed scope would include:
- a. installing mounting systems
 - b. mounting solar panels
 - c. DC circuit wiring if under 1000V nominal
 - d. AC side work limited to no more than installing a 1000V or less AC output feeder ran from an inverter to an existing AC interconnection point (breaker panel, switchboard, dedicated disconnect or panelboard installed by an electrical contractor, etc) and installing an overcurrent/disconnect device (breaker) at the same said interconnection point. (AES contractors would be disallowed from installing things like AC panelboards that are sometimes installed for the purpose of combining multiple AC inverters into a common output feeder, or doing things like modifying major switchgear to allow for a line side tap. These are done on solar installations but are more along the lines of electrical work than specific to an AES system).
 - e. If there is to be a KW (KVA may be a more appropriate term) size limitation, it could be based on the KVA of a given inverter's AC output rather than an entire system size.
 - f. AES contractors would be allowed to hire electrical and civil subcontractors for portions of a PV system that may fall out of their allowed scope.

Reason(s):

- Most of the very large scale PV systems are now 1500 V DC and over 5,000 MVA AC. Also many of the utility interconnected systems may have 1000 V or less DC system connected to 35 kV interconnection voltage source. In a few cases this could include projects as small as 500 KVA. So putting in this voltage differentiation would have several affects. Firstly it would help to ensure that AES contractors aren't going beyond their scope of expertise by installing medium voltage equipment because it happens to be connected to a system less than 500 KVA. It would however, allow an AES contractor to contract on a project to install multiple inverters on a customer campus, even if due to number of inverters at the multiple buildings, the system exceeds 500 KVA. It would allow an AES contractor who has a small amount of electrical or civil work outside of its allowed scope to hire a proper subcontractor for that work, despite not itself being so licensed. Lastly, however being that some of the components on systems over 500 KVA can be very much just more of the same components, there's no reason to say that an AES contractor shouldn't be allowed to be a subcontractor with a limited scope, on some of the larger projects. The mounting systems language, voltage limitation,

and limitation of amount of AC side work as proposed might strike a balance between allowing AES contractors to do similar work regardless of KVA size, while clarifying certain types of work they may not do, regardless of KVA size.

3. Highway/Heavy contractors allowed work on solar installations would only be on dedicated purpose solar generation projects where both of the following apply: the system has a dedicated utility interconnection (not tied into a building's service) and the total combined generation on the premises (regardless of whether utility owned or not) exceeds 5 MVA AC.

Reason(s):

- The 2017 national electrical code added the article 691, which covers large scale PV systems and has a threshold of 5 MVAC. Additionally many utilities don't do distribution level interconnections over 5 MVA AC. Often things such as incentive funding programs and power purchase agreement programs change as soon as something achieves or exceeds a 5 MVA AC size. The result of these factors is that projects over 5 MVA is where a large difference is.
- Generally there is much more engineering oversight and a lot more than just the adopted building codes being applied to ensure safety of an installation on these systems. On these systems, we nearly always always see more of the engineered design dictating the aspects of electrical layout that electrical contractors may in other cases be expected to know how to do, thus perhaps justifying the allowance for non-electrical, H/H contractors to do the work.
- Generally this system size is where we start seeing non-utility customer owned interconnection at voltages higher than the 35 KV medium voltage distribution level, and it's where we start seeing things like dedicated transformer substations that might more commonly have been seen on utility owned systems that some H/H contractors commonly install. Thus, utility contractors may have some competence overlap with electricians in these types of systems.
- These systems are usually not mounted to rooftops of buildings. As a result, the building level fire code regulations (that Electrical and AES contractors must be knowledgeable about) may not apply as often, meaning it may be acceptable for Highway/Heavy contractors to perform these installations.

Separate from the solar PV issue, I think there are 2 other licensing issues that the board needs to pay attention to (below):

- Currently, board regulations suggest that only CBC or RBC contractors might be allowed to manage the work of a licensed contractor doing work they themselves aren't licensed to do. (Example general contractor with only CBC hiring an electrician, or AES contractor hiring a grading contractor or an electrician to install a line side tap). It seems Highway/heavy and AES contractors should be allowed to do this as well.

- We might be needing to review on whether it is AES of Highway/Heavy or Electrical contractor licensing needed for large scale wind farms that are currently being installed, which take up hundreds of acres and are hundreds of feet tall.

Finally, a lot has been presented in this letter and there is likely more perspective to be had from other stakeholders. I therefore suggest that rather than any immediate action, that any permanent decisions on this matter be delayed to allow for proper consideration. I suggest in the interim that the board will need to be accommodation of current contractors as well as new applicants seeking to do renewable energy work.

Historic Contracting – Public Comment through Town Hall

Commenter: Historic Contracting, LLC
Modification to allow T & M or cost plus contracts

To whom it may concern,
We are very concerned, as many of my fellow builders are, with the building materials market volatility. Pricing has escalated far beyond controllable means. We have in excess of 2.5 million of new construction residential homes to build in the Richmond area and will not issue our contracts to our investor clients as we cannot guarantee that the contract amount will hold by the time the materials are delivered to the job site. We are planning to add language to our contract that would allow for the contract amount to be modified to recapture the material cost increases between the time of contract execution and actual delivery dates, plus standard and reasonable overhead and profit. Conversely, should the material amount drop below the original contracted amount then a credit would be issued to the client. In my opinion, T & M would not be practical on large projects. Very accurate cost accounting methods would have to be adhered to, insuring the process is accurate and fair to both parties. Copies of all material receipts and payroll logs with time sheets would have to be used and all of this only adds to the operating overhead and accounting of the project. If we are to be permitted to use the contract language that I am proposing, it would only be used when suppliers will not or cannot hold firm to their quoted material amounts. At this time several of our larger suppliers are holding their present quotes until March 15, 2022. Material need not be delivered to hold the price, but a purchase order issued and the quote signed off and accepted by us, the contractor and them, the supplier. We are all working through very challenging times and we all will have to work together for a successful and reasonable outcome.
