Ms. Henshaw provided the Committee with a draft of the Condominium Regulations that incorporated the suggested changes from the previous Committee meetings. The Committee discussed the draft text and made several additional changes.

Mr. Melson thanked the Committee for its work and the time dedicated by the members to conduct such a comprehensive review of the Condominium Regulations.
