Mr. Bright, determined there was a quorum and called the meeting to <u>Call to Order</u> order at 9:50 a.m.

Ms. Faye Prichard was introduced as the Board's newly appointed <u>New Board Member</u> citizen member. Ms. Prichard is a professor at Virginia Commonwealth University and the Mayor of Ashland, Virginia.

Ms. Tamika Watson was introduced as the new Administrative Assistant for the Board effective 3/26/2007.

Upon a motion by Mr. Shell and seconded by Ms. Taylor the Board Approval of voted to approve the agenda as presented. The members voting 'yes' Agenda were Mr. Bright, Ms. Prichard, Mr. Shell and Ms. Taylor. There were no negative votes. The motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Bright asked for public comment. There was no public comment. **Public Comment**

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Upon a motion by Ms. Taylor and seconded by Mr. Shell the Board voted to approve the minutes of the Board for Opticians December 8, 2006 board meeting as written. The members voting 'yes' were Mr. Bright, Ms. Prichard, Mr. Shell, and Ms. Taylor. There were no negative votes. The motion passed unanimously.

The Board reviewed its examination statistics for informational Examination **Statistics** purposes

The Board discussed the use of a Progressive Lens Identifier during the opticians practical examination. Ms. Kristi Ostrom, Opticians Instructor at J. Sargeant Reynolds Community College, provided information to the Board on the specifics and the benefit of the device. The Board agreed that use of the device did not give an exam candidate an advantage in passing the exam and that for the exam to be equitable all exam candidates should have an equal opportunity to use the device. The Board determined that in Richmond and Wytheville there may be 12 candidates taking this section of the exam at one time. The Board agreed to pursue obtaining 12 Progressive Lens Identifiers through donation or purchase and when the Board had obtained 12 it would allow its use during the examination.

The Board reviewed its quarterly board statistics for informational Quarterly Statistics purposes

Mr. Bright reported on his attendance at the National Committee of State Opticianry Regulatory Boards 2007 meeting on January 27, 2007 in St. Petersburg, Florida. Mr. Bright reported that the primary topics of discussion were (1) development of a national/regional practical examination, (2) standardizing apprenticeship education, (3) regulation of non-prescriptive contact lens (cosmetic contact lens), and (4) licensure of establishments.
