- Dr. Morrison fell ill prior to closed session and excused himself from the informal conference. He indicated that he wished to leave, and requested that the Committee proceed in his absence.

Additionally, Mr. Martinez de Andino moved that Ms. Sacksteder and Ms. Lee attend the closed meeting because their presence in the closed meeting is deemed necessary and their presence will aid the Committee in its deliberations. The motion was seconded and passed.

Within 6 months from the date of entry of the Order, Dr. Morrison shall successfully complete a 7 hour continuing education course in the subject of radiographic and diagnostic interpretation. Dr. Morrison was also ordered to undergo a physical examination and a comprehensive neuropsychological evaluation within 90 days from the date of entry of this Order.

Mr. Martinez de Andino moved to adopt the decision of the Committee. The motion was seconded and passed.
