Dr. Jackson moved to strike the last paragraph of page 2 of the RLRC's July 20, 2011, minutes. He stated that he did not make the motion. There was no second and the motion failed.

Dr. Tsai moved to approve the minutes of the May 11, 2011, meeting with amendment to include Dr. Jackson's request to add Attachment 2A. The motion was seconded and carried with a vote of two yeas and one no.

DISCUSSION ITEMS:

Advertising Guidance Document

Ms. Knachel provided an overview of the various draft guidance documents regarding the advertising of board certification. The RLRC's discussion included the following:

- Concerns with equality of advertising board certification among the licensees
- Possible options to narrowly define board certification;
- Advertising restrictions.

Dr. Tsai moved to request that Ms. Knachel provide a new draft that addresses the RLRC's concerns and recommendations. The motion was seconded and carried.

Electronic RX Guidance Document

Ms. Knachel informed the RLRC that she had received an inquiry regarding electronic transmissions of prescriptions to third parties and whether the transmission satisfied the requirement to give the patient a copy of their prescription.

The Committee remanded the matter to Ms. Mitchell for research
