Reconvene Open Session

Board of Corrections Jail Review Committee May 15, 2019

I MOVE that the Jail Review Committee reconvene our open session having concluded a closed session to discuss or consider medical and mental health records and to consult with legal counsel regarding specific legal matters requiring the provision of legal advice by such counsel. I MOVE that this committee and its individual members certify that during the closed session, the Jail Review Committee limited its discussion to matters lawfully exempt from the public meeting requirements and identified in the closed session motion. If a Member cannot so certify, I ask that they state the reason specifically on the record and that the recorder take role.

The Jail Review Committee *FINDS* that the evidence presented in these cases did/did not reveal any act or omission by the facility or any employee or agent thereof that may have directly or indirectly contributed to the inmate's death. The Jail Review Committee further *FINDS* that investigation revealed/did not reveal any evidence indicating that the facility was out of compliance with the regulations promulgated by the Board. *NOW THEREFORE*, *I MOVE* that the following cases be recommended to the Full Board for closure.
