Suggested Motion to Close Cases: The Jail Review Committee investigated the following cases by reviewing institutional, medical, and mental health records and other relevant evidence of the circumstances surrounding each death. The Jail Review Committee further finds that investigation revealed/did not reveal any evidence indicating that the facility was out of compliance with the regulations promulgated by the Board. *NOW THEREFORE, I MOVE* that the following cases be recommended to the Full Board for closure.

<u>Suggested Motion for Alternate Certification:</u> Pursuant to 6 VAC 15-20-100 (B)(3), your facility is *HEREBY* issued a *PROBATIONARY CERTIFICATION* for a period of (*TIME*) from the date of this *Order*. If your facility does not meet the requirements for certification at the conclusion of this period, the Board will issue a *LETTER OF DECERTIFICATION*.

Pursuant to Virginia Code § 53.1-68, the Virginia Board of Local and Regional Jails Support Unit Unit is hereby directed to conduct *(PERIODIC)* random unannounced focused inspections during the probationary certification period.
