The Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV) Care Services (HCS) Clinical Coordinator and Director of Division of Pharmacy Services (DPS) reviewed the Virginia Medication Assistance Program (VA MAP) drug utilization data, including CABENUVA regional data and the comparative use of it through the Ramsell system.

- Biktarvy® remains the most used single-dose treatment regimen for both insured and uninsured clients.
- CABENUVA is the most used treatment in the Northern region of the state through DPS and Ramsell.

The HCS Clinical Coordinator shared that language was added to the ADAP Advisory Committee's Scope of Work (SOW) to reflect the new state in-person meeting requirements. The document is pending final internal review. Committee members gave feedback regarding the Virtual Meeting Request form.

- The SOW will be emailed to committee members for final approval and voting.
- The HCS Clinical Coordinator should receive the Virtual Meeting Request form 30 days before the next meeting.

The Medication Access Manager provided updates on the 2024 insurance Open Enrollment and the Pharmacy Benefit Manager (PBM) implementation. The Committee Chair requested the committee receive the PBM communications.

Additional information was provided about the Change Healthcare cybersecurity issue and its effect on clients' medication access throughout the state. The VA MAP provided medication access through Direct MAP for insured clients unable to obtain their medications at retail pharmacies.

The Clinical and Data Administration Manager discussed the new HIV and Aging Collaborative Planning Group. The group's purpose includes bringing comprehensive education to case managers directly serving geriatric-age clients and developing strategies to improve overall health outcomes for people aged 50+ living with HIV (PLWH).

The Committee Chair and the RWHAP B Director provided feedback about the Health Resources and Services (HRSA) Administrative Reverse Site Visit held in November 2023. The overview focused on pharmacoequity, assuring that all individuals, regardless of race and ethnicity, socioeconomic status, or availability of resources, have access to the highest-quality medications required to manage their health needs. The data requirements and quality data management issues for the ADAP Data Report, required from all ADAPs, were also emphasized during the Administrative Reverse Site Visit.

The VDH Mpox Data team provided an epidemiological update, including provider testing, vaccination best practices, and effective treatment strategies employed throughout the Commonwealth. Supplemental to the Mpox update, the team shared information regarding a rise in acquired and congenital syphilis and an increase in prenatal HIV in the state of Virginia.
