The Board was updated that Esthetics Regulations went into effect September 20, 2007 and applications are being received/processed **Esthetics** 

The Board was informed that the Request For Proposal (RFP) for Master Esthetician Practical Examination ended October 17, 2007; no proposal were received; the DPOR Procurement Office will be contacting vendors to obtain information concerning the proposal; and that the current testing contract expires in December 2010 and the Board could consider options on developing a RFP at that time.

The Board was informed that pertaining to licensure by waiver of the examination, schools and businesses should not communicate to potential attendees that by attending their training course they will fulfill the requirement for licensure by waiver of the examination. All training will be assessed in the context of the total training completed. The Board and public were informed to contact the Board office if they are aware of such a situation.

Mr. Anders reported on his attendance at the NABBA conference September 15-21, 2007, in Orlando, Florida. He reported that "Teamwork" was the conference theme and there was discussion of how states could work together to have the same licensure (education hours, tests) requirements to assist in reciprocity. The entitlement of the barber pole was discussed. The 2008 conference will be held in Washington, DC.

National Association of Barber Boards of America 2007 Conference Report

Mr. Quesenberry and Zelda Williams reported on their attendance at the NIC annual conference and the NIC's board administrator's conference August 24-27, 2007, in Rapid City, South Dakota. The theme for NIC's 2007 Annual Conference was "Synergy Creates Building Blocks for Tomorrow". The sessions addressed topics such as Roberts Rules of Order, educational alternatives to disciplinary actions, pandemic preparations, two-tier esthetics, examination cheaters and consequences, newsletter design, cyber safety, conducting Board business, and boar member training. The 2008 conference will be held in Jackson Hole, Wyoming.

The form letter sent to complainants was discussed. The concern was that the letter indicated that the respondent might be forewarned of an inspection. Bonnie Rhea Adams informed the Board that the appropriate communication was determined by the type of investigation needed.

#### **Quarterly Newsletter**

The Board discussed the possibility of a newsletter to communicate pertinent issues and actions to licensees. Staff will research developing a newsletter that would be distributed electronically.

### Methyacrylate monomer (MMA)

Board discussed MMA, a product used as a bonding agent during the application of acrylic nails which the FDA has concluded to be a poisonous and deleterious (causing injury) substance that should not be used in fingernail preparations. Board regulations prohibit use of products banned by FDA.

### **Training**

15 minute Board member training that was presented at the NIC conference was discussed. Board staff will provide to DPOR staff for review.

#### **Board Member**

Board was informed of the resignation of Ms. Girardi and Mr. Howell, and that appointments are handled by the Office of the Secretary of the Commonwealth.

#### **Next Meeting**

The next meeting date will be January 28, 2008.
