Several inquires have been received by the board office about how to Out of Country obtain licensure when training has been received from abroad.

Training

The Board agreed that when an applicant's training is received from out of country the applicant shall provide evidence of training, education, competency and such documentation be translated in English in order to become eligible to sit for the exam. The Board also agreed that materials and supporting documentation must meet the Board's requirements set forth in the regulation.

An inquiry from a Virginia licensed optician who is interested in Contact Lens receiving the contact lens endorsement but does not have access training asked the Board how can he do this.

Training

Ms. Kristi Ostrom offered J. Sargeant Reynolds Community College as an option. Ms. Ostrom stated that J. Sargeant Reynolds offers an online contact lens training course and clinic sites set up by J. Sargeant Reynolds in the area convenient for the licensee.
