Chairperson French, finding a quorum of the Board present, called <u>Call to Order</u> the meeting to order at 8:35 AM.

The Board agreed without dissent to approve the agenda as Adopt Agenda prepared by staff. The agenda is attached.

Board Member Larry Lawson arrived at 8:35 AM.

Arrival of Board Member

Mr. Cawthron moved that the Board approve the minutes of the Approval of March 4, 2004 Informal Fact Finding as prepared by staff. Ms. Leininger seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously by seven "YES" votes (Messrs. Cawthron, French, Haley, Peaks, and Lawson, Dr. Grizzard, and Ms. Leininger).

Minutes

Mr. Cawthron moved that the Board approve the minutes of the March 9, 2004 Board meeting as prepared by staff. Mr. Peaks seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously by seven "YES" votes (Messrs, Cawthron, French, Haley, Peaks, and Lawson, Dr. Grizzard, and Ms. Leininger).

Ms. Leininger moved that the Board approve the minutes of the May 12, 2004 Public Hearing. Mr. Haley seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously by which was carried unanimously by seven "YES" votes (Messrs. Cawthron, French, Haley, Peaks, and Lawson, Dr. Grizzard, and Ms. Leininger).

Chairperson French opened the floor for public comment.

Public Comment Period

Mr. Wanless, of Wanless & Associates, brought to the attention of the Board a number of suggestions concerning frequently asked questions for CPE's. The Board referred the questions to staff for a response.

In the matter of File Number 2004-03207, Board v. Keith File Number Bellamy Ford, the Board reviewed the record, which consisted of 2004-03207 the application file, transcript and exhibits from the IFF, and the presiding officer's summary, conclusion and recommendation. Keith Bellamy Ford (respondent) was not present at the time of the Boards decision. Mr. Cawthron moved that the Board adopt the summary, conclusion, and recommendation and approve Mr. Ford's application for the Class IV Wastewater Works Ms. Leininger seconded the motion, which was examination. carried unanimously by seven "YES" votes (Messrs. Cawthron, French, Haley, Peaks, and Lawson, Dr. Grizzard, and Ms. Leininger).

Mr. Ford arrived after the Board had made its decision.

Chairperson French informed Mr. Ford that the Board approved his application to sit for the Class IV Wastewater Works examination.

Rachel Pustilnik, Virginia Department of Health, briefed the Board Examinations on the progress of the Class VI Waterworks examination pilot Update online testing project. Ms. Pustilnik noted that through the first three examinations, 61 candidates have taken the examination and Ms. Pustilnik recommended that the Board 57 have passed. continue using the Cooperative Extension to give the Class VI Water examination for another year and also expand the program to include the Class V Water examination.

Mr. Cawthron moved that the Board approve Ms. Pustilnik's recommendation to continue the pilot program for an additional year and expand the program to include the Class V Water examination. Mr. Haley seconded the motion which was carried unanimously by seven "YES" votes (Messrs. Cawthron, French, Haley, Peaks, and Lawson, Dr. Grizzard, and Ms. Leininger).

The Board discussed the suggested amendments to its regulations Regulatory Issues that would allow experience gained at a non-classified facility to count towards satisfying the experience entry requirement.

Mr. Cawthron moved that staff draft amendments to the Board's regulations that would:

- 1. Allow those that meet the entry requirements in 18 VAC 160-20-90, except for having experience at a certified facility, to sit for the examination provided they can show evidence of the required amount of experience at a noncertified facility that is equivalent to the experience gained at a classified facility;
- 2. Allow those so qualified that do pass the examination to be licensed as an operator after they provide documentation of having completed 50% of the required experience at a certified facility.
- 3. Allow education substitutions in accordance with 18 VAC 160-20-90.
- 4. Allow those meeting the non-certified experience requirement and passing the examination to be issued a "restricted" license, which shall NOT authorize them to operate a certified facility, but shall make them subject to all of the requirements of the Board's regulations, including the requirements for Continuing Professional Education (CPE) and license renewal.

Further, that staff submit the amendments to the members of the

Board for review by electronic mail before proceeding to mature the proposed amendments for public comment in compliance with the Virginia Administrative Process Act. Mr. Haley seconded the motion which was carried unanimously by seven "YES" votes (Messrs. Cawthron, French, Haley, Peaks, and Lawson, Dr. Grizzard, and Ms. Leininger).

Mr. Dick discussed the public comments received by the Board concerning the proposed fee increase.

Mr. Lawson moved that the Board adopt the summary of public comments and agency response as drafted by staff and adopt the fee structure as proposed. Mr. Grizzard seconded the motion, which carried. Members voting "YES" were Messrs. French, Haley, and Lawson, Dr. Grizzard, and Ms. Leininger. Cawthron and Mr. Peaks abstained from voting.

Ms. Leininger moved that the Board reconsider the prior question. Mr. Grizzard seconded the motion which was carried unanimously by seven "YES" votes (Messrs. Cawthron, French, Haley, Peaks, and Lawson, Dr. Grizzard, and Ms. Leininger).

Board Member Dr. Thomas Grizzard left at 11:45 AM.

Mr. Lawson moved that the Board adopt the summary of public comments and agency response as drafted by staff and adopt the fee structure as proposed. Mr. Haley seconded the motion which was carried unanimously by six "YES" votes (Messrs. Cawthron, French, Haley, Peaks, and Lawson, and Ms. Leininger).

The Board discussed the issue of requiring new license applicants applying to take the Waterworks or Wastewater Works Waterworks and examination to be subject to fingerprinting for the purpose of Wastewater conducting a criminal history records check through the Virginia State Police and the FBI.

Fingerprinting of **Works License Applicants**

Mr. Cawthron moved that the Board not proceed with requiring new applicants to be subject to fingerprinting. Mr. Peaks seconded the motion.

Mr. Cawthron asked to withdrawal the previous motion. Mr. Peaks agreed to the withdrawal.

Ms. Leininger moved that the Board establish a subcommittee to review the costs and benefits of performing criminal history records checks through fingerprints for license applicants.

committee will endeavor to complete its work and provide a report to the Board at its December 8, 2004 meeting. seconded the motion which was carried unanimously by six "YES" votes (Messrs. Cawthron, French, Haley, Peaks, and Lawson, and Ms. Leininger).

Chairperson French requested that Mr. Haley, Ms. Leininger, and Mark Anderson be appointed to the committee. The Board agreed without dissent to allow those individuals to serve on the committee.

The Board considered the application for training course approval Application for from the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ).

Training Course Approval

Mr. Peaks moved to accept Dr. Grizzard's recommendation and approve DEQ's course entitled "Activated Sludge Process Control, Part 2" for 2.0 training credits (TC's). Mr. Cawthron seconded the motion which was carried unanimously by six "YES" votes (Messrs. Cawthron, French, Haley, Peaks, and Lawson, and Ms. Leininger)

The Board took note that Penn State requested to withdrawal its Penn State application for training course approval.

The Board reviewed the results of the examination given on March Examination 26, 2004.
