THE VIRGINIA BOARD FOR WATERWORKS AND WASTEWATER WORKS OPERATORS

MEETING MINUTES

The Virginia Board for Waterworks and Wastewater Works Operators met on Wednesday, March 9, 2005 at the offices of the Virginia Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation, 3600 West Broad Street, Richmond, Virginia 23230.

Chairperson Leininger, finding a quorum of the Board present, called the meeting to order at 8:35 AM. Ms. Leininger introduced Frank Davis and welcomed him as the newest member of the Board.

The Board agreed without dissent to approve the agenda as <u>Adopt Agenda</u> prepared by staff.

Mr. Peaks moved that the Board approve the minutes of its December 8, 2004 Board meeting, the February 8, 2005 Criminal History Records Check Committee meeting and the February 8,

Mr. Vanderland 2005 Examination Review Committee meeting. seconded the motion which was unanimously approved by the following members: Leininger, Peaks, Cawthron, Grizzard, Davis and Vanderland.

Chairperson Leininger opened the floor for public comment. No member of the public present expressed a desire to address the Board.

Public Comment Period

In the matter of File Number 2005-00130, Robert J. Toney, the Board reviewed the record, which consisted of the application file, transcript and exhibits from the IFF, and the presiding officer's summary, conclusion and recommendation as amended by the Board. Robert J. Toney (Respondent) was not present at the Board meeting. Mr. Peaks moved that the Board adopt the summary and recommendation and approve Mr. Toney's application to sit for the for the Class IV Wastewater Works Operator examination. Mr. Grizzard seconded the motion which was approved by the following members: Leininger, Walker, Peaks, Grizzard, Davis and Vanderland. Mr. Cawthron recused himself and did not participate in any discussion or vote.

Mr. Stephen Ballou, Executive Director for the Association of **Presentation by** Boards of Certification (ABC) discussed new initiatives that ABC plans to undertake over the next several years. Several of the topics Mr. Ballou discussed with the Board were multiple entry testing, online testing and ABC's online certification database.

ABC Executive Director

Eileen Leininger, Chairperson of the Criminal History Records Check Committee presented the report of the committee along with its recommendations. Dr. Grizzard moved that the Board accept the Committee's recommendations that the Board hold in abeyance checking applicants for criminal history records, noting that if future events should make criminal history record checks necessary or appropriate, the required authority and capability exists to implement such checks in a relative limited time period. Walker seconded the motion which was unanimously approved by the following members: Leininger, Walker, Peaks, Cawthron, Grizzard, Vanderland and Davis.

Sharon Sweet, DPOR's Education & Exam Administrator, explained the circumstances surrounding a recent incident relating to questions on the waterworks examination which may have been illegally copied and distributed. Ms. Sweet indicated there will be increased monitoring and other procedures to reduce or eliminate any possible violations and that she will report back to the board at

Steve Cawthron, Chairperson of the Examinations Review Examinations Committee presented the report of the committee along with Review Committee options for the Board's consideration. Ms. Sweet reviewed the details of each of the options as well as the criteria for renewal of the current ABC contract. Mr. Cawthron moved that the Board authorize staff to publish a Request for Proposal (RFP) for examination services administering an electronic examination based on the Virginia item bank. Further, that a committee to be appointed by the Chairperson to assist Ms. Sweet in drafting the RFP and in evaluating the proposals received in response to the RFP for the purpose of awarding a contract. Mr. Peaks seconded the motion which was unanimously approved by the following Leininger, Walker, Peaks, Cawthron, Grizzard, members: Vanderland and Davis.

The Board agreed without dissent that the Examination RFP Committee come back to the Board before making any change to the open book nature of the examination.

Ms. Leininger appointed Mr. Vanderland and Mr. Walker to serve on the Examination RFP Committee along with Mr. Dick and Ms. Sweet.

The Board asked Mr. Dick to prepare an appropriate communication to the regulated community publicizing the RFP to obtain a computer administered examination.
