Proposed developments for the park include four small shelters, relocation of the maintenance area, 2 vault toilets, a comfort station/outdoor shower and the upgrades of the park road from Wash Woods to Dudley Island. The park is predicted to be highly impacted by storm surge and sea level rise, thus proposed developments at the park are minimal Public comments included a concern for hunting around the park. The citizens in attendance expressed general support for the plan. The draft master plan will next be presented to the Board of Conservation and Recreation for recommended approval.
