1. Informational Presentation:

Kristi Shalton, DCJS Law-Enforcement Division Regulatory Coordinator, on behalf of Lois Kinch, DCJS Training Standards Coordinator, presented information on the proposed revisions to the Civil Process and Courtroom Security Officer training standards. Also, the Jail/Court Security/Civil Process Curriculum Review Committee Members were present to answer questions regarding the revised standards.

There was a brief discussion about whether these additional requirements would add to the existing training time. Although there has been no discussion around the length of the additional training and/or how long it would take, it is not foreseeable that it would add any additional time due to the fact that some categories have been removed to reduce redundancy thereby creating room for the additional requirements.
